- Wauseon Middle School 77 students served, with 0 students helpseeking.
- Hilltop High School 22 students served, 4 students scoring 4 or higher on the screen, 2 students were determined to be at-risk for suicide, with 4 students help-seeking.
- Hilltop Middle School 12 students served, with 2 students helpseeking.
- Edon High School 19 students served, 5 students scoring 4 or higher on the screen, 2 student was determined to be at-risk for suicide, with 2 students help-seeking.
