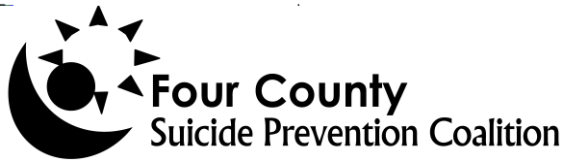

The amount reported was correct, but that an adjustment was made due to funds mistakenly applied to the coalition funds. This error was corrected and funds totaling \$33.80 was returned. There were no deposits or expenses since our last meeting. Therefore the balance remains the same as:  Leaving a balance of \$2, 412.45  2. LOSS update: Tonie L.	<p>LOSS Activity since 02/28/2019 (last meeting):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tonie reported that there have been 3 known deaths by suicide in the four county area since the February 28, 2019 meeting:</li> <li>2. Tonie discussed the recent response to the Fulton County ER. Responses to any ED were rare for the LOSS Team. LOSS had received feedback on the response, and an ad hoc had been developed to review and amend LOSS Processes and response protocol, in order to better serve the families, the Team and the four county ED's</li> <li>3. Tonie also discussed concerns regarding LOSS never being called to deaths in the Stryker PD jurisdiction. Coalition members suggested that PD be offered MHFA training.</li> <li>4. There will be a replacement team member training scheduled for Late April, 2019</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 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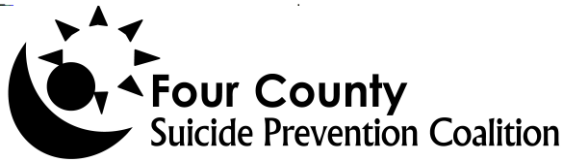
