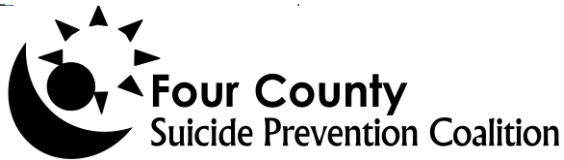

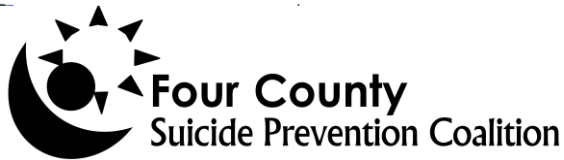

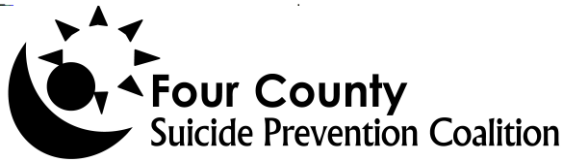

Ohio Suicide Prevention	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Tonie reported that she and Billie J Horner attended the Ohio Statewide Suicide Prevention Conference. Tonie shared information on the decline in emotional preparedness of incoming freshman. OSU reported that the University counseling and support services cannot keep up with student demand, in spite of multiple expansions. Incoming freshman are academically prepared, but emotionally unprepared. The university saw multiple campus suicides in 2017, and is taking steps toward prevention. The coalition members discussed the emergence of this locally, including ways to increase the resiliency of youth.

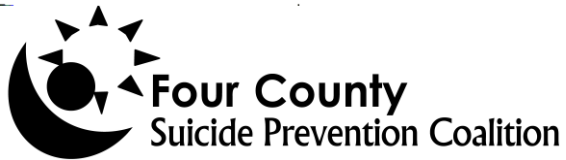
